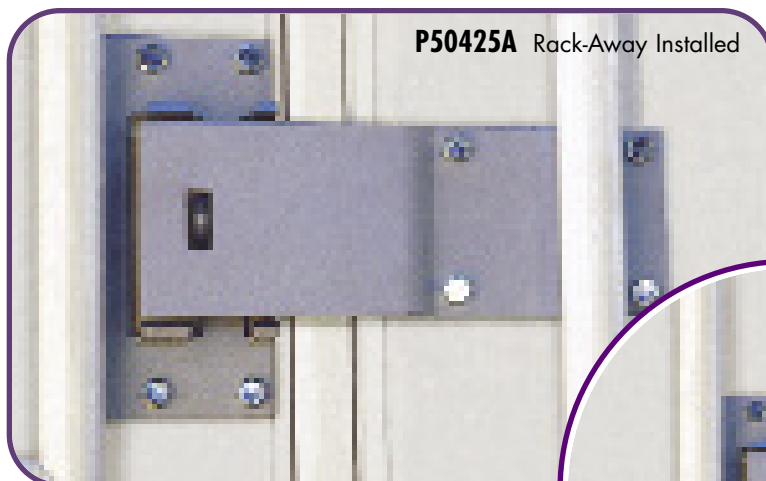
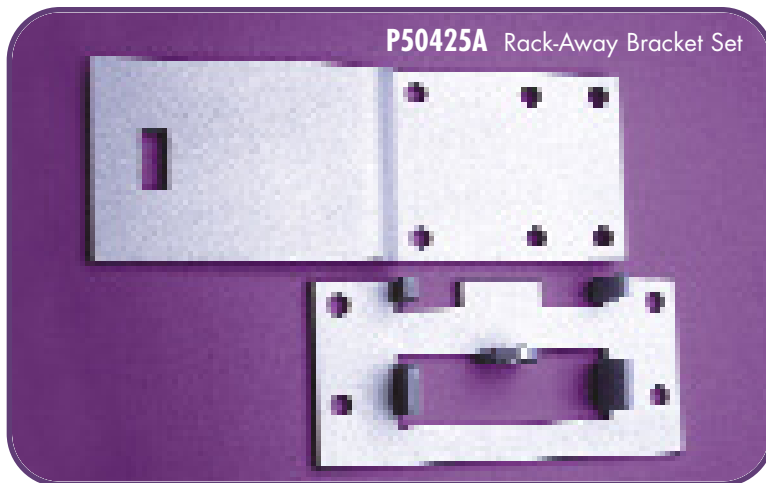


Rack-Away Anti-Racking Bracket

Door movement within the trailer end frame is a primary cause of premature wear on doors, seals, frames, hinges and lockrods. Rack-Away brackets are designed to restrict vertical door movement to help reduce damage caused by end-frame racking. You'll extend the life of your trailer doors while creating tighter seals and better door securement.

The Rack-Away system is ideal for older trailers with fatigued door systems and end-frames, because it realigns the doors, and reduces the need to repair doors. For new trailers, the brackets help extend the life of the doors and other parts, while maintaining door integrity, ensuring a tight seal for the life of the trailer body.

One Rack-Away bracket set solves most door racking problems. For severe racking problems, two Rack-Away sets are recommended. Rack-Away brackets install in minutes with standard door fasteners and tools. A padlock hole is provided to add additional security.
